

A' LEVEL RESULTS DAY

Advice for all our Yr 14 students who have applied through UCAS:

Below is an overview of key aspects of Confirmation and Clearing and some top tips to help you prepare.

Confirmation: The process of checking results against offer conditions. If conditions are met, the student's place on the course is confirmed. All decisions are shown in Track and letters are sent to students to confirm their place or the next steps they need to take to apply through Clearing. During August we will also send them an email when their place is confirmed.

Clearing: If students don't get the grades needed to meet their offers, they can still apply for other available courses, through Clearing. Universities and colleges can make offers through Clearing from early July, but applicants must have received their exam results before they can be considered and are only able to apply through Clearing if they are not holding offers elsewhere.

Adjustment: Each year some students achieve better results than expected. If they have met and exceeded the conditions of their firm choice they could be eligible for Adjustment. Adjustment gives them an opportunity to reconsider where and what to study.

IMPORTANT PLEASE NOTE:

If you have applied to St Mary's or Stranmillis University Colleges then you need to notify these colleges of your results yourself as they are not part of UCAS. The deadline for notification is **Monday 19th August**.
